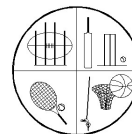

This year they have provided funding for Footballs new deep fryer in the canteen \$2.5K, funding for Crickets new lawn mower to replace the one stolen \$2.5K, funding for equipment for the new basketball facility \$2.5K and funding to assist this years Tennis tournaments \$2.5K.
